



### DATA SHEET CONTACT PERSON

**Definition of close contacts:**

Contacts of a confirmed COVID-19 case are defined as close contacts (with increased risk of infection) if at least one of the following situations is present.

Please answer the three questions below. If you answered **YES** to any of the questions below **and** you were not **fully vaccinated\*** at the time of your last contact with the index case, you meet the definition of a close contact person. You will receive all the necessary documentation from the health department after submitting your completed data sheet.

*\*Completely vaccinated persons are persons who have received all necessary vaccinations. They either have received a required second vaccination or have been vaccinated with a vaccine, which provides full protection even after a single vaccination. After the 15th day of the last vaccination, one is regarded as a completely vaccinated person.*

Standing close by the pos. COVID infected person (<1.5 m) for longer than 10 minutes without adequate protection (adequate protection = index case and contact person were wearing MNP [mouth-nose protection] or FFP2 mask continuously and correctly).

Conversation with COVID case (face-to-face contact, <1.5 m, regardless of duration of conversation) without adequate protection or direct contact (with respiratory secretions).

### EXEMPLARY CONSTELLATIONS FOR CLOSE CONTACTS

- Persons from the same household
- Persons with direct contact with secretions or body fluids, especially respiratory secretions of a case, e.g. by kissing, coughing on, sneezing on, contact with vomit, mouth-to-mouth respiration, etc.
- Persons who have been exposed to high concentrations of infectious aerosols indoors without adequate ventilation (e.g. celebrations, communal singing, gym). For these areas MNP/ FFP2 masks (except in health care/for trained medical personnel) do not provide sufficient protection against transmission.

- People who have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 on a flight lasting 5 hours or more (regardless of wearing an MNS/FFP2-mask).
  - Passengers who were seated in the same row as, or in the two rows in front of or behind, the confirmed COVID-19 case.
  - Crew members or other passengers, if any of the other criteria listed above apply (e.g. conversation; or similar).
